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PROCEDURE TO REQUEST INSPECTION TO REMOVE DEAD, DISEASED OR HAZARDOUS (DDH) TREES

- Submit a complete application for tree removal to the City Arborist either by:

Key Information for your application:

- Please include photographs of the parts of the tree(s) which are of concern in your application.
- Note that dead, diseased or hazardous tree (DDH) is a tree that is dead, untreatably diseased or infested, has a moderate or higher risk of failure with a target present, or has high to extreme risk of failure that cannot be mitigated.

Upon receiving a complete application, including photos, for a Tree Removal Permit, an inspection will be scheduled for the City Arborist to complete the inspection of your tree(s) within five business days. During periods of heavy volume, turnaround time may be longer. Applications will be processed in the order in which they were received.

- 4) A meeting with the property owner is not required, but access to property will be required.
- 5) Upon completion of the inspection, the City Arborist will approve, deny, or require additional information on the tree(s).
- 6) If tree(s) are denied for removal, you may file an appeal to the UDO Administrator. To file an appeal, contact John Maximuk at John.Maximuk@decaturga.com
